

Q1 In what state or U.S. territory do you live?









Q4 Which category below includes your age?









Q9 Did your teacher or counselor in school influence your choice of occupation you entered after school?







Q11 How old were you when you first thought about/considered entering your current occupation?




Q12 Do you want your child or stepchild to enter a particular occupation?








